

Start of Work at Mud Walls Secondary Road from 12 February 2024

The Department of State Growth will be doing road works on a 2.5 kilometre section of Mud Walls Secondary Road as part of the Freight Capacity Upgrade Program. The works are located between the towns of Campania and Colebrook.

The Freight Capacity Upgrade Program is a jointly funded Australian and Tasmanian Governments initiative and aims to improve safety for all road users.

The scope of work to be undertaken includes:

- road repairs
- resurfacing
- line marking

We have included a map to show the location of the project.







We will be starting on Monday, 12 February 2024, working between **7:00 am** and **6:00 pm (Monday to Saturday)**, until in May 2024, weather permitting.

We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside these times.

How will the work affect you?

During work hours, there may be wait times of up to 15 minutes when travelling on Mud Walls Road.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure workers and road users are safe including a temporary closure of one lane of traffic and a reduced speed limit during work hours. Outside of working hours, a reduced speed limit may still be in place, as the road conditions may have changed.

Please keep to speed limits, follow the directions of traffic controllers and signs, and allow up to **15 minutes** extra travel time during this work.
