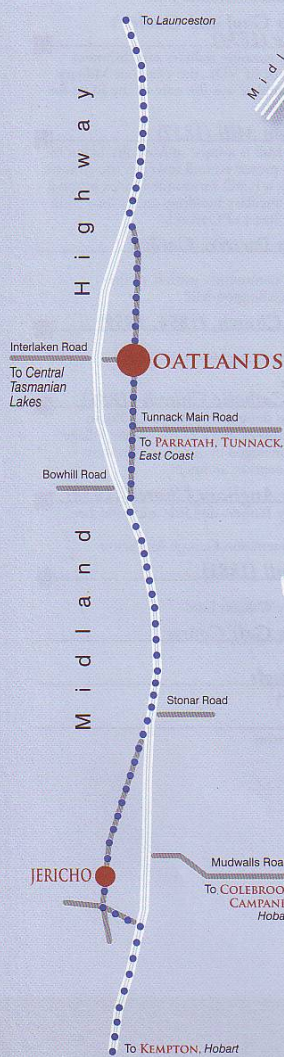




Founded in the mid 1820s, Oatlands began life primarily as a military establishment and a key component of the colony's convict system. Today Oatlands fortunately boasts the most intact Georgian sandstone buildings of any village in Australia, which accommodate a fine array of antique shops, tea rooms and colonial accommodation.

Oatlands Gaol and Gaoler's Residence (1834) 2
The longest running military establishment
in the interior of VDL, the Oatlands Military
Precinct complex was the core of the town for
many decades.

Callington Mill (1837) 3
Callington Mill is unique in Australia, being by
far the best-preserved mill tower in the country.
Importantly, it is still surrounded by its original
precinct of ancillary buildings and is located in
the historic heart of Oatlands
