## **Midland Highway Safety Upgrades Stage 2 Bagdad – Notification of Future Changes**

As part of the Midland Highway upgrade through Mangalore, VEC plan to commence works on the western side of the Midland Highway between Cornelian Hill and Eddington Road.

Works involve new road construction on all three Quarrytown Road access points to the Midland Highway. Additionally as part of the contracted works, the southern entrance to Quarrytown Road requires permanent closure and the construction of a new cul de sac.

The middle and north Quarrytown Road access points will remain open at all times to maintain normal access for local residents, customers to the Bennett's Service Station and bus operators. Single lane entry/exit at these two junctions is required to allow construction works to occur.

VEC plan to close the southern Quarrytown Road entrance and start works on the Quarrytown road accesses from Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> of January.
