As part of the maintenance of roadside vegetation, Southern Midlands Council undertakes a spraying program within both urban and rural areas, using Government approved chemicals. As part of the program, residents are invited to apply for their property frontage to be added to the No Spray Register. Current permit holders will need to re-apply.

If your application is approved, you must undertake control of the vegetation along the frontage of your property in accordance with Council's No Spray Register Policy. The policy can be viewed on Southern Midlands Council website or at Council Offices.
