TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF REGISTRATION

All dogs over the age of six months must be registered and microchipped, (unless exempt under Section 15A(2)(b)of the Dog Control Act 2000). Registration must be renewed by 31 July each year.

Southern Midlands Council issues lifetime tags for your dog's registration. These tags are a small metal stainless steel disc with your dog's unique registration number and councils contact number on one side, with the other side blank for you to engrave your contact details if you choose. Once your dog is registered and you have your lifetime tag, in subsequent years, all you need to do is pay the relevant registration renewal fee each year, much like registering your car. If you lose or damage your lifetime tag, replacement tags are available through council, a replacement fee applies.

The owner of a dog must notify the general manager in writing within 14 days of the dog's death, loss, removal, the transfer of the dog to another municipal area or change of ownership of the dog to another person.

Only two dogs or up to four working dogs can be kept on a property without a kennel licence, please contact Council for further information, or to apply for a kennel licence.

You must have the means to contain the dog(s) on your property. Fines apply for dogs at large and/or dogs not under effective control.

Dogs must be walked on a lead on any road related area, this includes pathways, nature strips and unsealed roads.

Dogs must remain under the effective control of the owner or person in charge of the dog at all times. This also includes when exercising your dog in a designated off-lead area.

The owner or person in charge of the dog(s) is responsible for cleaning up after the dog(s).

With the exception of Guide dogs and hearing dogs, all dogs are required to wear a collar with registration disc attached when in a public place.

If your dog is impounded, every effort will be made to return the dog home if it has the prescribed identification, (current registration and microchip), and if someone is on the premises. Impound fees are charged and an Infringement may be issued for any offence

PRIVACY STATEMENT

The information that the Council is collecting on this form is being collected by Council for sections 9 and 15 of the Dog Control Act 2000. The personal information will be used solely by Council for that/those primary purpose(s) or directly related purposes. The intended recipients of the information are Council officers, agents, or contractors of Council. Council may disclose the information to law enforcement agencies, courts and other organisations authorised to collect it. Failure to provide this information may/will result in your dog not being able to be registered and if your dog is not registered other penalties may be issued. You may make application for access or amendment to your personal information held by Council by contacting Southern Midlands Council.
