The modern Men's Shed is an updated version of the shed in the backyard that has long been a part of Australian culture.

Men's Sheds are springing up all around Australia. If you looked inside one you might see a number of men restoring furniture, perhaps restoring bicycles for a local school, maybe making bird houses or fixing lawn mowers. You might also see a few young men working with the older men learning new skills and maybe also learning something about life from the men they work with. About Us

The Community Men's Shed—Oatlands is supervised at all times by suitably qualified personnel and there is no requirement for members to have any previous experience in using the tools or equipment. Appropriate work safety practices are enforced and tuition on the use of all equipment is provided as needed. This supervision of day-to-day activities is undertaken on a voluntary basis by the Shed Coordinator. Overall management of the Shed project is also undertaken on a voluntary basis by a management committee comprising representatives of the principal project sponsors and various community groups.

Community Men's Shed members have access to an extensive range of woodworking tools and equipment that ordinarily may not be available to most hobbyists and handymen or to those with limited space. Projects that members may wish to undertake are limited only by their imaginations .

Membership

To join the Shed, simply visit during opening hours and chat with the Shed coordinator and with members. You will be made most welcome

Membership of the Shed is free, however members may wish to make a small contribution each time they attend, to help toward the cost of providing refreshments. Members are requested to bring their own lunch if attending all day.

Members are welcome and indeed encouraged to bring their own projects to work on at The Shed and as well, are invited to participate in small community projects.
